ii) <u>To give consideration to the West Berks Minerals & Waste Local Plan Preferred</u> Options Consultation

West Berks Council is currently preparing its Minerals and Waste Local Plan which will set out policies to manage minerals and waste development across the district. The Local Plan will also include allocated sites for minerals development to meet the Council's primary aggregate (construction material) need over the plan period. West Berks Council is now consulting on the Preferred Options Minerals and Waste Local Plan. This has been prepared taking into account national policy, as well as evidence gathering and comments made during previous periods of consultation. The Minerals and Waste Local Plan is subject to a Sustainability Appraisal (SA) and must also be prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) Directive. A SA/SEA Environmental Report has therefore been produced alongside the Preferred Options for consultation. All documents are available to view on the Council's website (www.westberks.gov.uk/mwlppo ). Hard copies are available for public inspection at West Berkshire Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD during office opening hours (8:30am - 5:00pm Monday to Thursday and 8:30am - 4:30pm on Fridays). Members are to review the documentation, with any comments to be presented at the June meeting for submission to WBC.

#### 6. Transport
