

## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

#### **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (Public Footpath Burghfield 3, Moatlands Cottages) Public Path Extinguishment Order 2020**

The above order, made on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020, under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish **Public Footpath Burghfield 3** running from point X (Grid Reference 466996 170245) on Field Farm Road in a south-westerly direction for approximately 140 metres, past Moatlands Cottages (postcode RG30 3TA), to point Y (Grid Reference 466909 170134) on the northern edge of the M4 Motorway as shown on the Order map.
