

**PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**West Berkshire District Council (Public Footpath Burghfield 3,
Moatlands Cottages) Public Path Extinguishment Order 2020**

This Order is made by West Berkshire District Council ("the Authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Authority that the public footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Burghfield Parish Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of Highways Act 1980.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The cul-de-sac public right of way running from Field Farm Road in a south-westerly direction for approximately 140 metres past Moatlands Cottages to the edge of the M4 Motorway, in the parish of Burghfield, and shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 1 of this Order, any statutory undertaker that has apparatus under in, on, over, along or across the public right of way for the purpose of carrying out its undertaking immediately before the date on which the public footpath is extinguished in pursuance of this order, shall continue to have the same right in respect of the apparatus as it then had

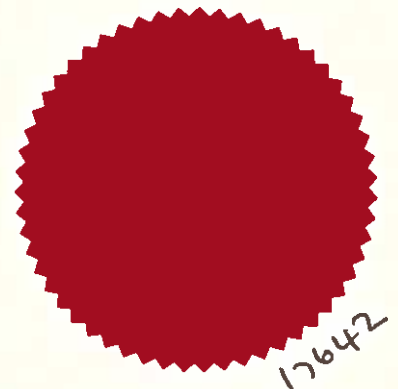
