### 12.0222 To undertake a review of the Standing Orders in relation to Chairmanship

Members considered the current wording contained within the Standing Orders relating to the maximum term of Chairmanship.

Resolved: To amend the Standing Orders with the following wording:

The Chair and Vice-Chair are elected by members of the Parish Council at the Annual Council meeting each year under Section 15 (1) of the Local Government Act 1972 with a maximum continuous term of five years. Should either wish to continue their term, the Parish Council can at this point elect to extend this term limit. The Chair and Vice Chair would be elected and voted to continue as two separate votes.

Proposed by Cllr P Lawrence, seconded by Cllr Gallagher and resolved with a majority vote, 1 abstention and 1 objection.
