Public Participation:

Mrs J Elmore raised concerns regarding the pop-up pub at the Kings Coronation event believing it to be unnecessary and objecting to the extension being applied for.

Mrs S Awbery raised similar concerns regarding drinking on the common recreation ground, believing a mixed message is being portrayed to the youth of the parish and drinking after hours being encouraged.

Mr G Townsend requested the green barrier to be opened to enable disabled access on the day. Mr G Townsend also answered specific questions regarding the pop-up pub for the benefit of those present.

Following a disturbance to the meeting, in accordance with Standing Order 2, the Chairman requested Mrs J Elmore leave the meeting. The meeting was suspended accordingly until Mrs J Elmore left the meeting and order was restored. The Chairman reconvened the meeting at 19.15pm.

The application is to be determined by the 28^{th of} June 2023.
- iii) To confirm the dates for the distribution of the tender documentation for progression Resolved: Members present resolved unanimously that the request for the tender to be distributed as soon as possible to ensure an operator can be installed and fully functionable prior to the end of the summer period.
