7.1023 Transport

i) To consider any Highway or Road Safety improvements within the parish

Members were advised that a Community Speedwatch Seminar had taken place on 25th October 2023 at West Berkshire Council Offices.

Notification had been received from WBC in relation to improvements being made to Tyle Swing Bridge. A full road closure is in place for the 6th November 2023.

ii) Update on SID request to WBC

A request has been presented to WBC for Cllr Thorrington to attend SID training. Upon completion a request is to be presented for the replacement of the SID within the parish.

Notification had been received from Sulhamstead PC regarding the placement of a SID on the Reading Road, near to Three Firs Way. The data collected is to be shared with the parish council.

8.1023 <u>Safer Communities</u>

Members were advised of the Police surgery held on the 14th October 2023. No report had been received from the police as to the level of attendance at the surgery.

A request for the night cells has been placed SSE be actioned as soon as possible.

12.1023 <u>To discuss questions for inclusion in Parish Plan questionnaire</u>

The following potential objectives were considered for inclusion within the parish plan questionnaire: *Reduction of speed, road safety, cycleways, energy saving and conservation.* The item is to be revisited in January 2024.

Members discussed the potential for all street lights within the parish, including West Berkshire Council owned, to be switched off at night. The question is to be raised with WBC and included within the parish questionnaire to determine parishioners interest in energy reduction.
